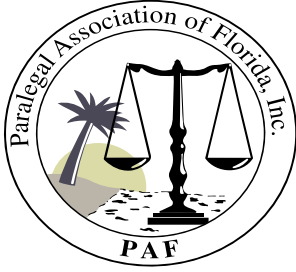

What to do while visiting Cocoa Beach

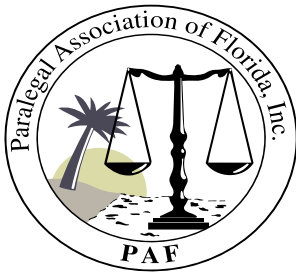

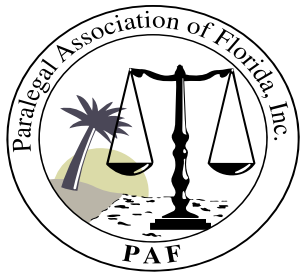
